
Hirsch Index Scores

for Leading ESRL Scientists in Atmospheric Chemistry



Definition: The Hirsch Index, denoted by **h**, is a measure of the scientific impact of the peer-reviewed publications that an individual scientist has authored or coauthored.

The Index is equal to the maximum number of publications, **h**, that have at least **h** citations from other peer-reviewed publications.
